LET'S ADD THE FINAL EASY CONJUGATION: "LET'S"

If we want to tell others "Let's do (something)", we use the same general steps as before but this time, we add "vkets" / "vkes"!

Mecetv (to do) --> Mecvkets! (Let's do it)

Take the dictionary form

Hompetv

Drop the 'etv'

Homp

Add 'vkets' or 'vkes' to the end




MOST COMMON VERB IN MVSKOKE:

Ometv





OMETV = "TO BE"

It's used to say "___ is ___"

It's always the very last verb in any sentence that it is a part of

It can be used by itself or with other verbs

So let's learn the first way to use it



THE WAY OMETV WORKS IN A SENTENCE

The parts of a sentence using "ometv"

(noun)* (noun) t + ometv conjugated

That horse it is

Mv rakko tos

Mv rakko tos =

That is a horse

What's a noun?

A noun is a: person, place, thing, or concept

For some you can put the words "a" or "the" in front of!

- Car
- City
- House
- Teacher
- Family
- Cat
- Love
- Happiness

The first noun has an *

That is because sometimes, you don't need that first noun. For things like *I, you, we, she, he, etc,* you don't need to include those words because it will be shown in the conjugated form of 'ometv'

CONJUGATIONS FORMS FOR OMETV

1st person singular	"I / me"	"l am"	towis	Pose towis I am a cat
2nd person singular	"You"	"You are"	tonces / towetskes / toweckes / tontskes	Pose tonces (etc) You are a cat
3rd person singular	"He / She / It / etc"	"He / She / It / etc is"	tos	Pose tos He / She / It is a cat
1st person plural	"We"	"We are"	towēs	Pose towēs We are cats
2nd person plural	"Y'all"	"Y'all are"	towatskes / towackes	Pose towatskes Y'all are cats
3rd person plural	"They"	"They are"	towakes*	Pose towakes They are cats



HOW DO WE USE THESE CONJUGATIONS?

These conjugations show who the subject is! That means, for many sentences, we can skip the "S" in "SOV"

l am a woman

Hokte towis

Woman I am

Y'all are students

Coky-hecylke towatskes

Students y'all are

Figure out what your Subject and Object will be for the sentence

You are a teacher
Subject Verb Object

If the subject is "I", "You", "He", "She", "It", "We", "Y'all", or "They", the verb will show the subject

Place the object first, then the correct form of ometv


teacher = mvhayv You are = tonces

Mvhayv tonces
teacher you are



Wakv tos **Este-cahtv towakes** cow it is person-choctaw they are "They are Choctaw" "It is a cow" **Cepane towetskes** Eli mvhayv tos Eli teacher she is Boy you are "You are a boy" "Eli is a teacher" **Sparky efv tos Este towēs** Sparky dog it is person/people we are "Sparky is a dog" "We are people"
