PAST 2 GRAMMAR

Past 2 is generally used to talk about things that took place yesterday to several years ago. It is a very common past tense in every day life.

The process for Action Verbs and Stative Verbs are almost identical to their Present Tense Conjugation.

ACTION VERBS

1. Take the action verb

2. Drop the 'etv'

3. Add the Person Marker

4. Add the Past 2 ending

5. Add 's'

Action Verbs can form Simple Past 2,
'Tos' Auxiliary, and 'Ometv
Conjugated' Auxiliary. In those cases,
